FAQs about Safety

Last Tuesday was an event that many are still reflecting on and below are the two main questions which keep arising:

What is the difference between a LOCKDOWN and a FACILITY ALERT? A Lockdown is when the school is in immediate danger. All doors will be locked, windows will be covered if possible, lights will be off, and students/staff will be hiding as best as they can to be out of sight. A Facility Alert (Code Yellow) means that there is something dangerous in the area, but not directly on site. We still secure students/staff inside by locking doors, but business goes on as usual, or as usual as it can, depending on when we call a Facility Alert.

Why did it take so long for parents to get notified? Please know that our FIRST concern is the safety of your children. We need to make sure all students are safely secured before we do anything else. Then, we need to make sure we have accurate facts to report out to the community. We can't compete with how fast word travels with social media and technology, but our main goal is that your children are safe. Also, note that announcements like "Crazy Sock Day" are scheduled notifications; we cannot predict unforeseen circumstances.

Parents, we encourage you "TO BE IN THE KNOW" The simplest way is to make sure you are signed up for text messages from the school. Text 81010 to @reagancom (short for Reagan Community). Also, May 17th, 2017 will be our next Parent meeting and we will be updating our Safety Plan for the next school year.

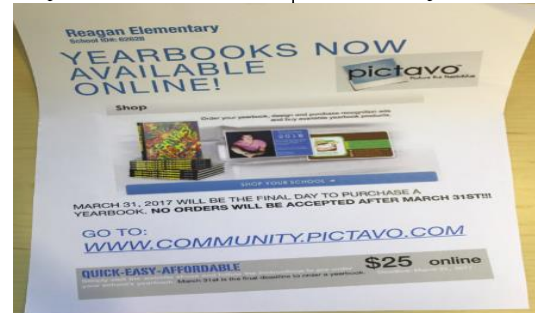
