Attention 6th Graders

Students Need Tdap Vaccination to Start 7th grade

Effective July 1, 2012, under California law known as AB 354, prohibits advancement into 7th grade unless the student has been fully immunized. Effective January 1, 2016, under California law known as SB 277, exemptions based on personal beliefs will no longer be an option for the vaccines that are currently required for students entering into 7th grade in public schools in California. Most families will not be affected by the new law because their children have received all required vaccinations. Personal beliefs exemptions on file for a child already attending child care or public school will remain valid until the child reaches the next immunizations checkpoint at 7th grade.
