Dress Code Reminders

Growth spurts and colder weather are bringing out some dress code concerns, which we would like to address as reminders before January.

Hats/beanies/etc. are allowed if they are represent Reagan, Clovis East, or Clovis Unified affiliated programs. Solid colors are also allowed if they are school colors: navy, dark green, white, or gray/silver. Everything else is considered out of dress code.

Leggings are allowed if the top layer is in dress code, meaning the top layer covers the bottom and goes to mid-thigh.



Hair...this seems to be the toughest area with dress code. Here is the direct line from CUSD Board Policy which Reagan follows.

B. Grooming

1. Hair shall be clean and neatly groomed.
2. Hair or mustache styles which cause undue attention are not acceptable; e.g., unusual designs, colors, symbols, messages, mohawks, Faux-Hawks, or unusual razor cuts. Complete razor shaving of the head is allowed.
3. Beards are not allowed. Sideburns are allowed, but may not extend past the base of the earlobe or be wider than one inch (1").
4. Bangs or other hairstyles must not obstruct nor interfere with vision.
