At-Home Support

- Talk with your child about being responsible for his or her choices at home and at school. Set clear expectations and consistently reinforce your child for meeting those expectations. When your child displays an undesired behavior, specifically teach and practice the desired behavior.
- Look for opportunities to attend our Parent Academies to learn more about behavior. These will be announced in the weekly PAW Prints.

PAW Store

- Students who show PACK Pride throughout the day can earn blue PAW tickets. Each Friday they can "buy" items at our PAW Store with their tickets. There are many items ranging in price from 3 tickets to 200 tickets.
- Our first quarter of this year's PAW Store has been a huge success... students have been excited to redeem their tickets for an item of their choice! New items are coming this quarter!!!

Leaders of the PACK

At the end of every month, each teacher chooses two or three Leaders of the Pack from their class. These are students who have gone above and beyond showing PACK Pride.
