CONGRATULATIONS TO OUR REAGAN STAFF! We have been recognized by the state of California as a PBIS (Positive Behavioral Intervention Support) School at the Platinum level for the 7 consecutive year! What does this even mean as a parent? This means at Reagan we have developed a positive plan for discipline that is utilized as a school-wide approach to proactively prevent or reduce challenging behaviors and produce positive outcomes. Students are directly taught the school-wide expectations in each area of the campus regularly using both examples and non-examples of appropriate behavior. Students are then rewarded (PAW tickets, Leader of the PACK) for illustrating the expected behaviors across campus by any staff member on campus. This allows for positive behavior choices to be cultivated in students and modeled for others. The goal of PBIS is to create a positive school environment, so that all students feel safe and can learn and grow!

Just as we have tiered academic interventions available, we also have tiered behavior interventions available. In 2017, Reagan became the first school in CUSD to earn Platinum level status and we have maintained that status for 7 years. We continue to review and improve our system to ensure we are meeting the current needs of our student population. This year we have included a social-emotional learning component to our PACK Pride matrix to encourage the development of the "other people mindset".

Positivity Project (yr 5), school pride and belonging to the Wolfpack all play an important role in developing positive student behaviors. Our Reagan staff remain dedicated to their role in educating our T-Wolves in mind, body, and spirit – this award is a demonstration of their hard work each day!
